Imagination Library is a free early childhood literacy program available in Calhoun, Cleburne & Randolph Counties, providing books to more than 4,042 children each year.

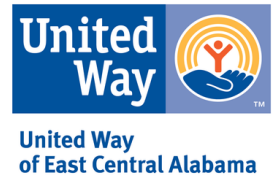
